Toks Okeniyi is the Head of Programmes and Operations at FORWARD, the lead organisation in the UK tackling female genital mutilation (FGM) and other gender based violence. At FORWARD Toks develops transparent decision-making processes within the UK Programmes, Project Teams and Senior Management in line with the values of FORWARD. In addition, Toks leads on the planning and delivery of Psychosocial Educational sessions on FGM.

Prior to joining FORWARD, She was Director of Services and Acting Chief Executive at the Royal Court of Justice Advice Bureau, an organisation that helps litigants in person navigate the court system and comply with civil procedure rules.

She served at several organisations designing and delivering successful programs in management development, team building, diversity, communications, customer service, change management, training, and performance management as well as many other topics.

Toks holds a post graduate qualification in Law, Project management and is also a magistrate. She is a fellow of the Royal Society of Public Health and Chartered Management Institute UK.

She is passionate about ensuring that individuals who are vulnerable or discriminated against are able to avail themselves of their rights and have a credible voice.
